

Membership in Installatörsföretagen – for companies with business in Sweden

If you **intend to have business** in Sweden, we need the following documents from you before we can grant you membership in Föreningen Installatörsföretagen:

- A document that proves that you are a registered company in your country (with national tax authorities or other national authority) in English.
- An F-skattsedel, from <u>www.skatteverket.se tax application</u>
- A Liability insurance, in English.
- Any company carrying out electrical installation work on an installation which is not its own must register with the National Electrical Safety Board before starting the work. (<u>Register your</u> <u>company</u> | <u>Elsäkerhetsverket</u> (<u>elsakerhetsverket.se</u>)).
- A filled in application form for membership in Installatörsföretagen (The Swedish Installation Federation) with signature of CEO
 A filled in application form for membership in Svenskt Näringsliv (Confederation of Swedish Enterprise)

Before we can grant your membership, we also need to have a personal meeting with you to inform you what a membership in Föreningen Installatörsföretagen means – what your rights and obligations are.

As a rule, employers who are members of the Confederation of Swedish Enterprise through membership of an employers' association are required to take out insurance for their employees under current collective agreements. Please see separate information about *collective insurances on www.in.se.*

The membership in Föreningen Installatörsföretagen is linked with a compulsory membership in our umbrella organization, Svenskt Näringsliv – *The Confederation of Swedish Enterprise*. This means that you pay a membership fee to both organizations. Due to taxation reasons, Föreningen Installatörsföretagen and Svenskt Näringsliv have their activity divided into two companies.

The fee to Installatörsföretagen is based on the annual turnover (in Sweden) previous year. The turnover has been limited to 3 150 000 SEK per employee and will be multiplied with the percentage below.

Member with sales from

- 0 kr to 100,000,000 SEK has an annual fee of 0.145% of turnover
- 100,000,000 SEK to 250,000,000 SEK has an annual fee of 0.120% of turnover
- 250,000,000 SEJ and higher has an annual fee of 0.105% of turnover
- Minimum annual fee is 6 000 kr

The fee to Svenskt Näringsliv is based on the wages paid for employees (working in Sweden) previous year. 0.09% x (total annual salary - 500,000 SEK). The minimum annual fee is 500 SEK/ year/ company.
